In Focus: Credential Validation Service Program Titling Tips

Developing a program at your college? CVS is here to help! Here are some important considerations and reminders regarding program titling.

Is your proposed program aligned to a **Program Standard or Program Description?**

If a proposed program aligns to a Provincial Program Standard (PPS) the title of the standard MUST be used.

**Note: Colleges MAY add a modifier (PPS Title – modifier) to a Program Standard but the modifier must be supported by a minimum of two additional Vocational Learning Outcomes (VLOs)

Example:

Business - Sustainable Agriculture

**CVS Tip: a hyphen highlights a program'speciality.

If a proposed program aligns with a Program Description, consideration is given to both the MTCU code titles as well as the existing APS program titles. There is more flexibility in these cases.

**Note: Colleges must maintain alignment with other titles of the same MTCU code, with at least ONE word from the MTCU code in the title.

Example:

MTCU Code 70523

MTCU Title: Big Data Analytics

Proposed Program Title: Applied Data Analytics

Does the proposed program title describe the field of study?

- ✓ Program titling must reflect the field of study and not a job title or position.
- Titles must not contain delivery mode or language references

Would students and employers understand the program title?

- ✓ Program titles clearly align to the field of practice and are clear to both students and employers.
- The title should align with the program's Vocational Learning Outcomes (VLOs).

Creative Solutions Management	Unclear field of study.	Creative Industries Management
Interdisciplinary Support for Child and Family Treatment	Question: What value does the added words "interdisciplinary support" have from a student or employer perspective? The interdisciplinary lens may emerge as a VLO.	Child and Family Treatment
Supply Chain Management - Local, National and International Operations	Use a hyphen to delineate a specialized focus.	Supply Chain Management-Global Supply Chain Management-Global Operations OR Supply Chain Management-Global Logistics
